 - Why is surrendering to God's will important in the spiritual battle for ourselves and our families?
 - *Jesus modeled surrendering to the will of the Father in the Garden of Gethsemane and on Calvary. Through surrendering to the will of the Father, he redeemed mankind. We are called to do the same.*
 - Why is the idea of surrendering so difficult for men?
 - What is required in our relationship with God the Father that will enable us to completely surrender?
 - *Trust*
 - How do we come to know the will of the Father?
 - *Prayer*
 - What areas of your life do you need to surrender?
- Play second video: **The Sacred Heart of Jesus**
 - Discuss video:
 - If you were asked why the Fishermen practice the First Friday devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, how would you explain it?



- *The Sacred Heart devotion is a devotion of love for Jesus. Its aim is to love Jesus who has so loved us, to return love for love The First Friday devotion is a form of Sacrifice that we make to Jesus in prayer and adoration in reparation for our sins and the sins of the whole world.*
- What has been your experience of fasting on First Fridays and taking part in the Holy Hour of Reparation?
- As we complete our 11th session of Fishermen CORE training, have you witnessed any discernable difference in your knowledge and understanding of your faith?
 - In the practice of your faith? *There is a major step from knowing about Jesus to knowing Jesus.*
 - How have the changes you have made in your life affected your relationships with family and friends? With God?
- Consecration Final Notes
 - As we come down the homestretch of our preparation – do not give up!
 - Discuss the plans for the Marian Consecration (Date, Time and Location).
